RULES FOR TENNIS COURT USAGE – 2018

1. The use of the tennis courts is restricted to those property owner's whose maintenance fees are current. The tennis courts are available to residents of Cape Royale under the following rules:
 - A Property Owner may use the Tennis Courts by signing out the key from the gatehouse.
 - A Tenant of a Property Owner may use the tennis courts if a permission form is signed by the Property Owner.
 - A guest of a Property Owner/Tenant ("Resident") must be accompanied by the Resident.
 - The person using the tennis courts must be 17 years of age or over.
 - For those under the age of 17 using the tennis courts, the Resident/Parent must be in attendance for the duration of the usage.
2. The tennis courts are available for use between the hours of 7AM and 11PM and may be used for tennis only. No animals, baseballs, basketballs, etc. allowed on courts.
3. Court key can be picked up from the gatehouse between 7AM and 10PM.
4. The person signing out the key will be responsible for the key and any damages to the tennis court. The tennis gate must be locked, and lights turned off after use and key returned to gatehouse.
5. Tennis courts are monitored daily.
6. If these rules are not followed privileges can be suspended.
